- Doctor's degree (although a doctorate will be a requirement for Grade I, someone with a doctorate will not necessarily obtain Grade I accreditation)
- Proven professional publication record in accredited periodicals, books or chapters in books
- Project outputs as consultant

2.2 Grade II

- Masters degree / Honours
- Publications – not necessarily in accredited periodicals
- Research outputs – successful completion of research projects and or
- Project outputs as consultant

2.3 Grade III

- B-Degree or similar technical qualification / or experience
- Publications – not a requirement
- Research outputs – should have been a member of a research team or have completed individual research
- Must be re-evaluated every four years

Ethical code for accredited members of the South African Society for Cultural History

1. Members will perform professional projects in accordance with basic conservation and preservation principles as far as possible. This implies that acknowledged principles in research, cultural resource management and sustainability should apply with regards to the subject under scrutiny.
2. Members will give the highest recognition to the cultural and historical integrity of the subject under scrutiny and will strive to maintain this integrity as far as possible.
3. Members will personally be responsible for the credibility of research results and the data which is applied.
4. Members will adhere to the legal prescriptions as is set out in the National Heritage Resources Act (25 of 1999) and regulations issued by the national and relevant provincial and local authorities involved in heritage.
5. Members will cooperate with the authorities and report any threat to the South African cultural heritage to the relevant authority.
6. Members will not become involved in any illegal actions with regards to the South African cultural heritage. This includes illicit trafficking in cultural heritage products.

7. Members must actively discourage the misrepresentation and misinterpretation of their work.
8. Members will contribute to the general education of the community with regards to the conservation of the cultural heritage and provide ethical leadership in this regard. At the same time the values of the community are to be considered in the studying and conservation of the cultural heritage.
9. Members should strive to oppose, as far as possible, projects which could harm the cultural historical integrity of the landscape or to convert them into conservation projects.
10. Members should manage professional activities in an honest way and restrain themselves from committing fraud, being prejudiced or distorting the truth. This includes refraining from accepting tasks which are not within their particular field of expertise. Members who become aware of such unethical conduct should report it, with supporting evidence to the Council of the SASCH. The Council may cancel such transgressor's accreditation.
11. The SASCH is indemnified against any malpractice by accredited members and may not be held responsible for any actions taken by any of its members.

Etiese kode vir geakkrediteerde lede van die Suid-Afrikaanse Vereniging vir Kultuurgeskiedenis

1. Lede sal professionele aktiwiteite so ver as moontlik in ooreenstemming met die basiese beginsels vir bewaring, konservering en preservering beoefen. Dit beteken dat erkende beginsels in navorsing, kultuurhulpbronbestuur en volhoubaarheid ten opsigte van die onderwerp wat ondersoek word, sal geld.
2. Lede sal die hoogste erkenning gee aan die kulturele en historiese integriteit van die onderwerp wat ondersoek word en sal daarna streef om hierdie integriteit so ver as moontlik te handhaaf.
3. Lede sal persoonlik aanspreeklik wees vir die kredietwaardigheid van navorsingsresultate en data waarmee daar gewerk word.
4. Lede sal hulle hou by wetlike voorskrifte soos uiteengesit in die Wet op Nasionale Erfenishulpbronne (25 van 1999) en regulasies uitgereik deur die nasionale en betrokke provinsiale en plaaslike owerhede wat met erfenis gemoeid is.
5. Lede sal met die owerhede saamwerk en enige bedreiging van die Suid-Afrikaanse kultuurerfenis by die betrokke owerheid aanmeld.
6. Lede sal self nie betrokke raak in enige onwettige handeling t.o.v. die Suid-Afrikaanse kultuurerfenis nie. Dit sluit o.a. die onwettige handel in kultuurerfenisprodukte in.
7. Lede moet die wanaanwending en foutiewe interpretering van hulle werk aktief ontmoedig.
8. Lede sal bydra tot die algemene opvoeding van die gemeenskap t.o.v. die bewaring van die kultuurerfenis en etiese leierskap in die verband bied. Terselfdertyd sal die gemeenskap se waardes in ag geneem word in die bestudering en bewaring van die kultuurerfenis.
9. Lede moet hulle, sover dit moontlik is, beywer om projekte wat die kultuurhistoriese integriteit van die landskap skade kan berokken, te opponeer, of om dit te omskep in bewaringsprojekte.
10. Lede moet professionele aktiwiteite op 'n eerlike wyse hanteer en hulle weerhou van bedrog, vooroordele en verdraaiing van die werklikheid. Dit sluit onder meer in om nie take aan te pak wat nie binne die vermoë van die betrokke kultuurhistorikus is nie. Lede wat bewus word van sodanige onetiese optrede deur ander lede moet dit onverwyld en met die nodige bewyse by die Raad van die SAVK aanmeld. Die Raad kan sodanige persone se akkreditasie kanselleer.
